Nominations of students will be accepted from parents, classroom teachers and special area teachers. Students may also nominate themselves. Nomination forms are available on the district website, [here](#) and in each school office. Students who have been identified in previous years do not have to be re-nominated. Students who were previously nominated and did not meet the eligibility criteria may be re-nominated once annually.

Nominated students will be screened through teacher observation and an assessment process.
