Dear Parents and Staff:

The Clinton Public Schools received notification today of positive COVID-19 test results for two members of the Joel School community. In accordance with CDC and Department of Public Health guidelines, the affected individuals have been instructed to isolate for 10 days from the date of the positive test. One individual was last in the school building on Friday, January 8, 2021 and the other on Monday, January 11, 2021.

In partnership with the CT River Area Health District (CRAHD), our local health district, contact tracing was conducted today and all individuals who were determined to be in close contact with the positive cases have received a phone call and have been informed about required actions.

Please remember that all students, staff, and parents can work together to control the spread of COVID-19 and implement the mitigation strategies of mask wearing, social distancing, and hand hygiene that have been shown to reduce and control the spread of COVID-19. If any staff or students exhibit any of the symptoms related to COVID-19 they should stay home, call their medical provider to report their symptoms, and notify School Nurse Supervisor Donna Frechette at <u>dfrechette@clintonpublic.net</u> or 860-664-6572.

The District will continue to immediately respond to notifications of positive COVID-19 cases of students or staff in the district, to work closely with the CT River Area Health District, and to communicate with our families and staff all required information and notifications.
