Travel Advisory Update 3/19/21

Connecticut's Travel Advisory Guidance has been updated as of today. The new guidance provides recommendations but not mandates. We know that following the guidance is an effective method of reducing transmission of COVID-19 and request that if you are traveling that you review the guidelines outlined below and follow these best practices.

<u>Travel Advisory Guidance (Effective 3/19/21)</u>

As of March 19, 2021, Governor Lamont's Executive Order No.9S, Section 1 regarding travel is no longer in effect. Connecticut residents and travelers to Connecticut should follow travel-related guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Connecticut Department of Public Health (CT DPH). Mandates and requirements are not currently in place in Connecticut.

In order to keep our school community healthy, Clinton Public Schools recommends that all students and staff review and follow the CDC and CT DPH recommendations for travel in and out of CT. Please thoroughly read the Travel Advisory Update linked below which includes information about your travel risk and suggested actions to take before and after travel. We ask that you pay special attention to the "After Travel" section.
